Martin has been gigging for around a year and a half. He has a regular MC slot at 'See You Next Tuesday' new act/material night at the Artista Café in Hove.




RUNI TALWAR

James was born in Grimsby but he escaped to Brighton. He's been gigging on the open mic circuit in Brighton, London and anywhere but Grimsby for nearly two years.




PATRICK HORE
